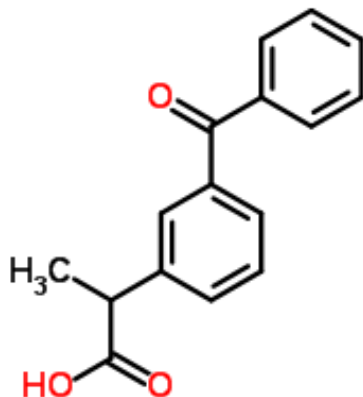

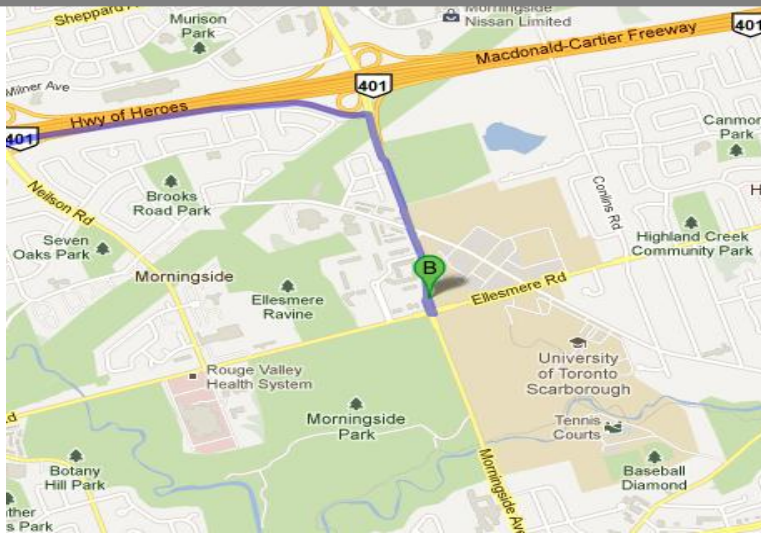

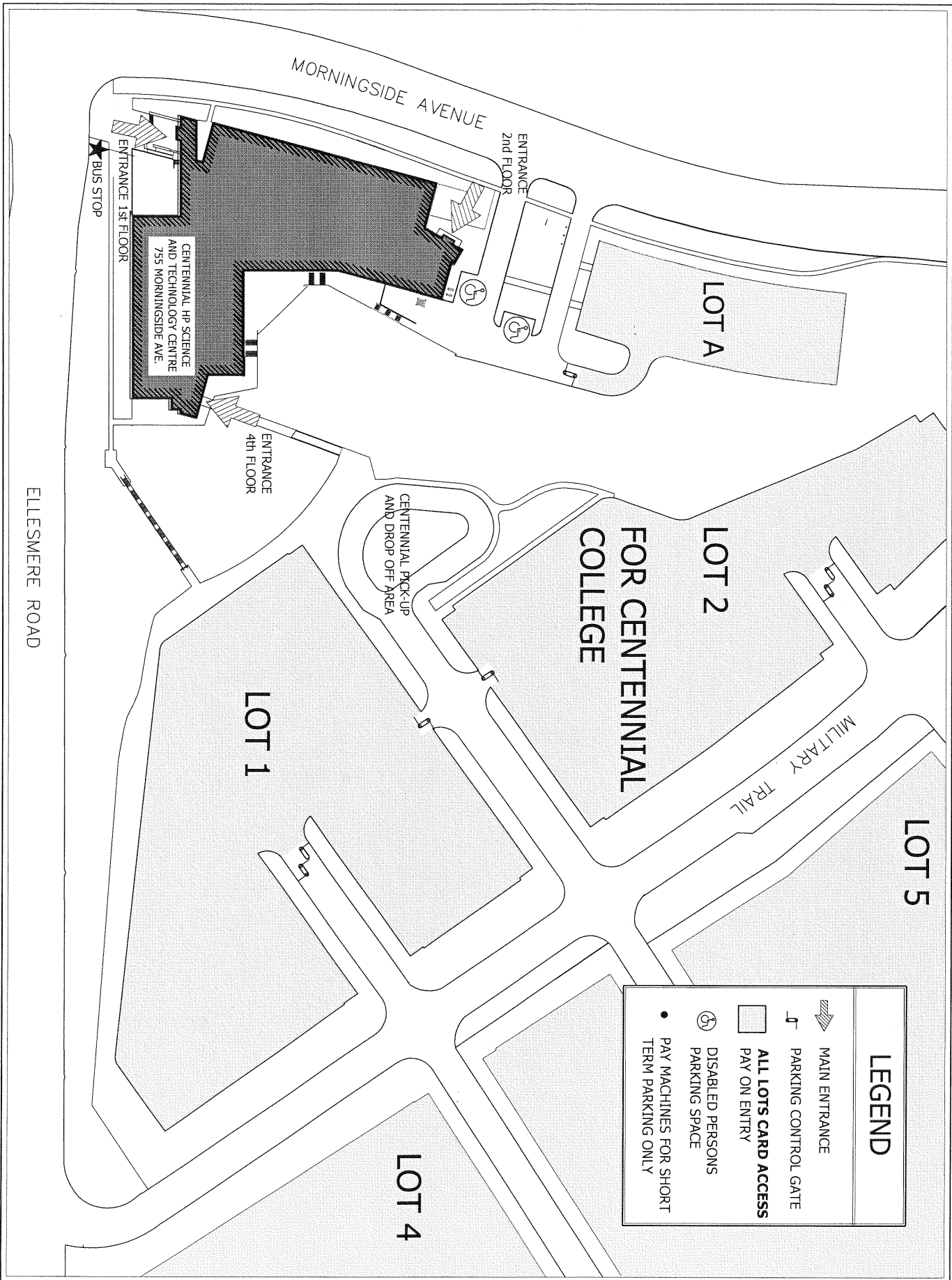

Centennial HP Science and Technology Centre (CHPSTC) – *Parking Information*

Permit and Pay Parking Hours are 24 hours per day, seven days per week. **There is no free parking during Continuing Education hours at this campus.**
